Carnevale sull'Acqua – Carnival on Water

Sunday 4th & Sunday 11th February

There is a reserved area for people with disabilities who can watch the parade in comfort from the 'Barletta' side in Via Pescheria, which can be accessed from Palazzo Bellini's courtyard. This entrance will open at 1 p.m.

In case of bad weather, the Carnival will be postponed until 18th & 25th February

CARNEVALE DI CENTO

Sunday 28th January, Sunday 4th February, Sunday 11th, Sunday 18th & Sunday 25th February 2024, at 2 p.m.

This is an exciting Carnival and one of the most important in Italy and in Europe. It is twinned with Rio de Janeiro. Its impressive floats move slowly around the main streets of the city and prizes and sweets are thrown to the crowds below. There is music and dancing, colourful and imaginative costumes and displays. On the last Sunday of the Carnival the winning float is announced in the main piazza and there is a spectacular firework display to bring celebrations to an end.

This year there is a 'Made in Italy' theme with Italian cars proudly leading the parades including Ferrari, Fiat 500 and Alfa Romeo as well as an exciting American car parade on Sunday 18th February.

You can buy tickets at the various entrances to the Carnival on the day which cost €17. Children who are less than 1m 20cm tall are free.
